3 Ways to Plan for College and Earn Scholarships from Home This Spring

The coronavirus has created new and unexpected challenges. School is canceled, but your future isn't. You can still get ready for college—and even turn your efforts into scholarships—at home from any device.

The **College Board Opportunity Scholarships** program provides a six-step guide to help you plan, prepare, and pay for college. For each step you take, you have the chance to earn scholarships from \$500 to \$40,000. This program is currently open to all class of 2021 students, regardless of citizenship status, in the U.S., Puerto Rico, and other U.S. territories; students at DoDEA schools abroad can also participate. The scholarships don't require an essay, application, specific test score, or minimum GPA. At least half the scholarships will be designated for students whose families earn less than \$60,000 per year. The scholarships can be used at any two- and four-year college or university.

Here are three things you can do from home to stay on track for college and earn scholarships:

1. SIGN UP FOR THE PROGRAM WITH YOUR COLLEGE BOARD ACCOUNT

2. BUILD YOUR COLLEGE LIST. EARN A CHANCE AT \$500.

Estimated Time: At your own pace (at least 30 minutes)

Finding simple resources to prepare for the SAT® doesn't have to be a hassle. Use free [Official SAT Practice on Khan Academy®](#) to keep your skills sharp. By practicing for 6 hours or more, you earn a chance for a \$1,000 scholarship.

- Take recommendations: When you link your Khan Academy and College Board accounts, you'll get practice recommendations based on your PSAT™ 10, PSAT/NMSQT®, or SAT results. Your recommendations are also based on how frequently skills appear on the SAT.
- Take a full-length practice test: Khan Academy has 8 full-length timed practice tests to build your stamina for test day. These tests give you personalized study recommendations based on your performance.
